Tax claimed by The Royal Edinburgh Repository and Self Aid Society

- The Royal Edinburgh Repository and Self Aid Society will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.
- The Royal Edinburgh Repository and Self Aid Society will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008.
- The Government will pay to The Royal Edinburgh Repository and Self Aid Society an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for The Royal Edinburgh Repository and Self Aid Society does not affect your personal tax position.
